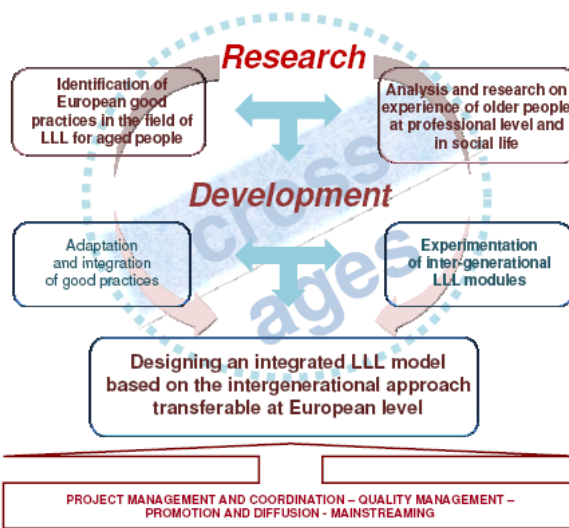

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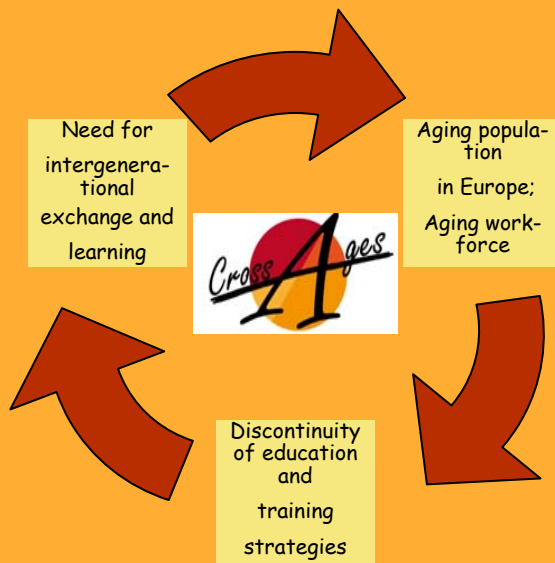
Aim, objectives and goals

Project aim

- favouring intergenerational exchange in which aged people could bring their long-term life experience and younger people could contribute with their updated

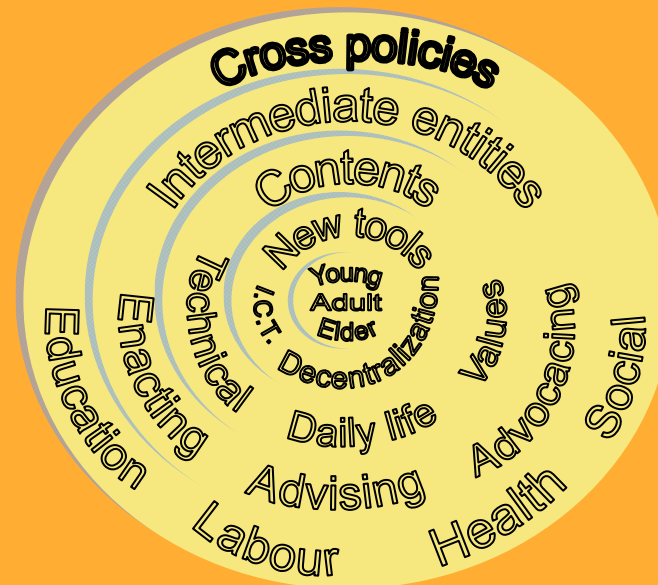


A new LLL model
